Gorgeous conditions greeted competitors for the inaugural race of the 2010 NE Harbor Fleet Cruising Class Season. Seven boats worked upwind from Bear Island to the Seawall shore in a WSW breeze of 12-15 kts. Far Out set the pace with Sidewinder and Tern working the shifts as they worked the top half of the beat trying to stay close to the big red boat. During a long downwind leg to East Bunker ledge the RC changed the next legs from Fleet Mark L to the Entrance Bell of the Western Way with a return to finish at Gilpatrick Cove. This gave competitors a challenging upwind leg along the Cranberry shore with the tide beginning to ebb. Far Out took the cannon but Commodore Bob Johnstone on Tern edged them out by 1'38" on corrected to capture the first win on the 12 mile course.
